Local Public Transportation:

Direction from Pennsylvania Convention Center to ICSA Meeting at University of Pennsylvania (PCPSE Building, 133 S 36th St, Philadelphia, PA 19104)

From Convention Center (1101 Arch St), walk south about 0.1 mile (4 minutes) to the 13th St SEPTA station located at 13th St & Market Street, take the Market-Frankford Line (to the direction of 69th Street Transportation Center), after 3 stops (15th St station, 30th St. station and 34th St. station), get off at the 34th St. station, then walk 6 minutes south to the PCPSE building located at 133 S. 36th St.

Subway fare \$2.50, runs every 12 minutes.



Directions to Philadelphia:

From John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK): Take AirTrain to Jamaica Station and transfer to Long Island Railroad to New York Penn Station. From there, take Amtrak to William H. Gray III 30th Street Station. (Slower Amtrak alternative on commuter lines: from New York Penn Station, take New Jersey Transit train to Trenton and then change to SEPTA train to William H. Gray III 30th Street Station).

From Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR): Take AirTrain to Newark Liberty International Airport Station. From there, take Amtrak to William H. Gray 30th Street Station. (Slower Amtrak alternative on commuter lines: from Newark Liberty International Airport Station, take New Jersey Transit train to Trenton and then change to SEPTA train to William H. Gray III 30th Street Station).

From Philadelphia International Airport (PHL): Take SEPTA Airport Line to William H. Gray III 30th Street Station.
